1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

1.1 Title & Jurisdiction:

The 2012 Lancashire Automobile Club Speed Championship is organised and administered by the Lancashire Automobile Club (LAC) in accordance with the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Championship Regulations.

1.3 Competitor Eligibility

1.3.1 Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the LAC and in possession of a valid 2012 MSA Entrants Licenses.

1.3.2 Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the LAC, be Registered for the Championship and as a minimum be in possession of valid Competition (non-race) National B Competition License.

1.3.3 All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing on.

1.4 Registration

1.4.1 All eligible Lancashire Automobile Club members competing at Championship rounds will be automatically registered for the Championship.

1.4.2 Entry to the Championship is free.

1.4.3 The closing date for entries is the final Championship round.

1.5 Championship Rounds

1.5.1 Championship rounds will include all Lancashire Automobile Club (LAC), Longton and District Motor Club (LDMC), Chester Motor Club (CMC) speed events and the Lancs & Cheshire Car Club (L&CCC) Anglesey events:

1.6 Scoring

1.6.1 Points will be awarded on an index of performance basis for the class as run on the day, including any class amalgamations. The index of performance shall be calculated as follows :-

$$\frac{\text{Average time of top three in class}}{\text{Championship Competitors time}} \times 100 = \text{Championship Points (to 2 decimal places)}$$

Where there are less than three competitors in a class then the number of competitors in the class shall be used to determine the Average time. Where a class includes BTD or FTD that competitor's time shall be used in calculating the Average time for that class.

Competitors are requested to enter each championship event under LAC or include the LAC Speed Championship under championships on the entry form. Competitors may score points on a maximum of 5 of the Championship rounds. Where Competitors exceed this number their lowest Championship scores shall be dropped until the correct number of events is reached.

The maximum score on any individual round is limited to 105 points

1.6.2 Ties shall be resolved by recalculating the Competitors Championship Points to 3 decimal places. If this fails to resolve the tie then the Championship Points shall be recalculated to 4 decimal places.

1.7 Awards

1.7.1 The awards will be presented at the Lancashire Automobile Clubs Annual Dinner Dance.

Awards shall be as follows:-

First overall £100, the Mylchreest Trophy (to be held for one year) and replica	
Second overall (subject to six Qualified Competitors)	£50 and a trophy
Third overall (subject to 10 Qualified Competitors)	£25 and a trophy
Fourth overall (subject to 12 Qualified Competitors)	£10

Only competitors who score points on 4 or more rounds will be recognised as qualified competitors
